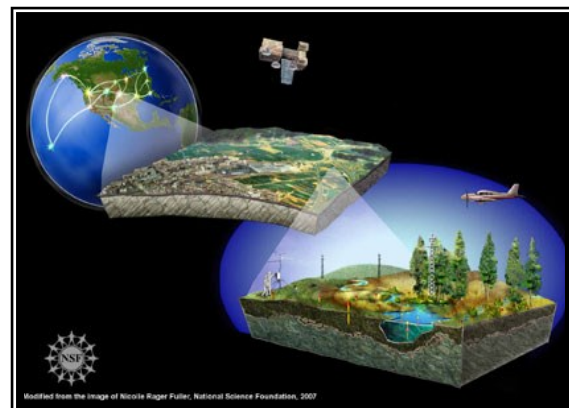

Enabling a Better Understanding of Continental-Scale Ecology NEON is designed to gather and synthesize data on the impacts of climate change, land use change and invasive species on natural resources and biodiversity.
